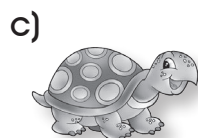
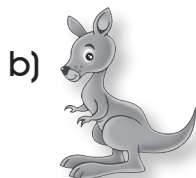

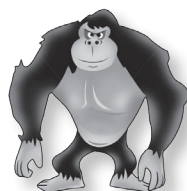

Kangaroos

The kangaroo is one of Australia's most famous animals. There are over 60 different species of kangaroos. Kangaroos of different types live in all areas of Australia. Kangaroos can weight between 55 and 90 kilos and a large male can be 2 meters tall.

Kangaroos eat plants. Most kangaroos are nocturnal but some are active in the early morning and late afternoon.

Kangaroos of all sizes have one thing in common: powerful back legs with long feet. Most kangaroos live on the ground and are distinguished from other animals by the way they jump with their strong back legs. A kangaroo's tail is used to balance while jumping.

All female kangaroos have front-opening pouches, where the 'joey', or young kangaroo, is raised until it can survive outside the pouch.
