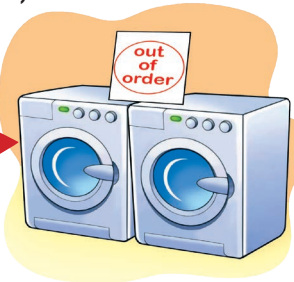

If + Present Simple- modal (will, can, may, must)+ infinitive

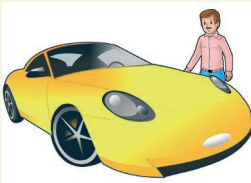
Ex.: If you join the club, you'll do a lot of fun activities.

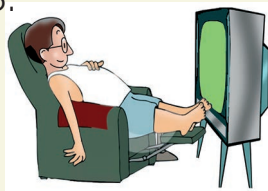
